Introduction

The Baltimore School of Massage (BSOM) offers a Professional Massage Therapy Program with both day and evening part-time and full-time classes. This is a career oriented course of study designed for students who may want to practice in a medical setting. BSOM has campuses located in Maryland, Virginia, and Pennsylvania.

Purpose

The primary purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transfer of credits from the BSOM Massage Therapy program to the CCBC Associate of Applied Science degree program in Massage Therapy.

Admissions Statement and Credit Transfer

1. CCBC will accept a minimum of 22 credits earned from BSOM.
2. Students who have completed 22 credits, as outlined in the attached document, may transfer into the Associate of Applied Science degree program in Massage Therapy at CCBC.
3. Only courses in which a grade of “C” or better is earned will apply toward the major at CCBC.
4. CCBC only recognizes college-level experiential learning gained through previous work, military and/or volunteer service, or life experience. Credit for prior learning may also be established through course challenge or standardized credit by examination.

Financial Aid/Scholarships

1. BSOM students transferring to CCBC will be given every consideration for Financial Aid and will be eligible to compete for academic scholarships upon entrance to CCBC subject to stated scholarship deadlines.
