Introduction

Morgan State University is one of the few historically black institutions in Maryland. It is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Higher Education. The University has the advantages of both suburban life and proximity to an urban center. Built on two slopes, the campus is strategically located in the picturesque northeastern Baltimore. The center of the city is easily accessible from the campus.

The University offers a comprehensive range of academic programs on all levels from Bachelors to Doctorate. Morgan is also a founding member of the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC).

Purpose

The primary purpose of this Agreement is to facilitate the smooth transfer from CCBC to Morgan's Baccalaureate degree program after students earn their Associate degree from CCBC.

Admissions Statement and Credit Transfer

After completion of an A.A./A.S./A.T.T. degree or 56 credits or more, prior to attending classes at Morgan, courses taken at CCBC for the general education requirements will be

accepted toward Morgan's general education requirements. Students need a GPA of 2.0 or better to be admitted.

Financial Aid/Scholarships

All domestic students transferring to Morgan are strongly encouraged to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The Federal School Code for Morgan is 002083. To file electronically, please visit www.fafsa.ed.gov. For information about signing your application electronically, please visit www.pin.ed.gov.

Students transferring from CCBC to Morgan may be eligible for the Maryland Community College Transfer Scholarships offered by/through Morgan. Scholarships include, but are not limited to:

- a) Bridge Grant Scholarship. CCBC certificate recipients with 24 or more credit and a GPA of 2.5 or higher may receive \$500 per semester towards education expenses.
- b) Tuition Scholarship. CCBC associate degree recipients, or those with 56 credits or more, and a GPA of 3.0-3.49 may have their full tuition and fees paid by attending Morgan through the Tuition Scholarship.
- c) Honors Scholarship. CCBC associate degree recipients, or those with 56 credits or more, and a GPA of 3.5 or higher may receive full tuition and fees, free room and board, plus \$500 book allowance by attending Morgan through the Honors Scholarship.
