Intermediate Sculpture and Advanced Sculpture

Explores advanced theories and practices related to additive and subtractive sculpture approaches in the round and in relief; provides models for figure and portrait studies. 3 credits each: 2 lecture hours and 2 laboratory hours per week.
Prerequisite: ARTS 141 or Permission of program coordinator.
