Description

Paramedic Assessment Based Management

Applies knowledge of patient assessment and prehospital management of a variety of medical and trauma emergencies; develops advanced life support skills.

Prerequisites: EMST 105, EMST 110, EMST 210, EMST 211, EMST 212, EMST 213, EMST 214, EMST 220, EMST 221, EMST 222.

Overall Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course the student will be able to:

1. Discuss how assessment based management contributes to effective patient and scene management.
2. Describe factors that affect assessment and decision making in the prehospital setting.
3. Outline effective techniques for scene and patient assessment choreography.
4. Identify essential take-in equipment for general and selected patient situations.
5. Outline strategies for patient approach that promote an effective patient encounter.

Describe techniques to permit efficient and accurate presentations of the patient.

Major Topics

Advanced Patient Assessment and Management

Course Requirements

Students registered for EMST 223 must maintain advanced life support affiliation with a Maryland volunteer, career, or commercial ambulance company at all times while enrolled in the CCBC Essex EMT Program.

Mastery level for all written examinations is 75%.

Successful completion of this course, in combination with EMST 220, 221, 222, and 224 is required for the student to be eligible to sit for the National Registry of EMT's Paramedic examinations.
