Description

Paramedic Clinical Practice

Provides opportunity to practice emergency and non-emergency advanced life support assessment and management under the direct supervision of a preceptor/mentor; provides variety of clinical settings including field EMS unit, operating room, neonatal and pediatric departments, psychiatric unit, and burn center.

Prerequisites: EMST 105, EMST 110, EMST 210, EMST 211, EMST 212, EMST 213, EMST 214, EMST 220, EMST 221, EMST 222, EMST 223.

Overall Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course the student will be able to:

1. Gather, evaluates, and synthesizes information.
2. Makes appropriate decisions based on the information.
3. Takes appropriate actions required for patient care.

Major Topics

Preceptored/Mentored Clinical Experience.

Course Requirements

Students registered for EMST 224 must maintain advanced life support affiliation with a Maryland volunteer, career, or commercial ambulance company at all times while enrolled in the CCBC Essex EMT Program.

Mastery level for all written examinations is 75%.

Other Course Information

This course is offered during the Spring only.

Successful completion of this course, in combination with EMST 220, 221, 222, and 223 is required for the student to be eligible to sit for the National Registry of EMT's Paramedic examinations.
