**Description**

Landscape Design Studio

Provides individual critiques on various landscape designs; expands on landscape design principles taught in Landscape Graphics (Hort 107) and Landscape Design (Hort 230).

Prerequisite: Hort 107 and Hort 230, or consent of the instructor

**Overall Course Objectives**

Upon completion of this course the student will be able to

- A. draw landscape designs applying the basic principles and theory of landscape design.
- B. interpret landscape designs and design process verbally, in a clear, concise language.
- C. respond to critique questions using proper principles and theory of landscape design.
- D. transfer landscape designs from paper to the ground.

**Major Topics**

1. Applying the Basic Principles and Theory of Landscape Design
2. Presenting the Principles of Landscape Design through the use of Landscape Drawings
3. Presenting a Design Process for each Landscape Design and Interpreting Verbally in a Clear, Concise Language
4. Interpreting Landscape Drawings and Locating Design on the Ground
5. Using Library Resources to Complete Course Assignments
