Description

Architectural Rendering for Interior Design

Introduces the concepts and skills needed to prepare perspective renderings of architectural interiors and furnishings; investigates the concepts and principles of one and two point perspective systems, quick sketching techniques, rendering of various textures and applications of color to drawings.

Prerequisites: INTD 101, ARTS 110.

Objectives

At the completion of this course, you should:

1. Understand and be able to apply the principles of one and two point perspective.
2. Be able to prepare perspective drawings using orthographic plans and elevations.
3. Be able to draw quick perspective sketches of existing architectural space and of conceptual designs
4. Be able to do renderings of various interior textures and understand basic coloring techniques of architectural renderings.
