Internship: Interior Design
2 credits

COURSE GOAL:

The course objective is designed to give the advanced Interior Design student practical experience in an actual work environment. Pre-Reqs: INTD 242

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Students must submit a proposal of what goals they want to accomplish on the job. The teacher must approve this proposal, and then the student must submit it to their employer who must put in writing their acceptance of the goals and procedures.
2. Students will keep a DAILY journal of work experience during work hours.
3. Students must work a minimum of 90 hours.
4. Employer must give a written evaluation of the student's goals that were listed in their original proposal.
5. Students must complete a final report
6. All work submitted must be typed.

Students will present a 7-10 minute oral report on their internship experience during Finals week, actual date TBA.
