Overall Course Objectives

1. To develop an awareness of and an appreciation for works composed and /or arranged for big band.
2. To develop musicians’ expressive potential and to teach the art of communication through music.
3. To train musicians in effective practice and performance techniques.
4. To train musicians in techniques associated with performance, including: quality of sound production, intonation and blend, ensemble awareness, musicianship, improvisation, articulation and stylistic interpretation, counting habits and rhythmic precision.
5. To develop a professional attitude and respect for fellow musicians.
6. To create a healthy atmosphere conducive to building the teamwork that is essential to the success of the ensemble and the musicians’ personal growth.

Major Topics

1. Exposure to music composed and/or arranged for big band in various styles and from various decades.
2. Weekly rehearsals conducted by ensemble director.
3. Encouragement to attend live big band performances.
4. Listening assignments related to works being performed.
5. Performance at end of semester concert.

Course Requirements

1. Regular attendance at weekly rehearsals.
2. Effective use of individual practice time.
3. Evaluation/critique of performance proficiency and musical growth by ensemble director.
4. Active participation in concert performance.
