Description

Clinical Practicum II

Continues the sequence of clinical practica which provide a total of ten clinical rotations in family practice, internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, pediatrics, surgery, emergency medicine, community medicine, psychiatry, a general elective and a primary care elective. During this fifteen-week course, the student is assigned to three five-week rotations.
