Introduction to Clinical Education
2 Credits

Description

Introduces students to clinical education via simulated labs and the first exposure to clinical experience.

2 credits; 2 lecture hours; 0 laboratory hours required.

Prerequisite: ENGL 052 or LVE2 or LVE3 and RDNG 052

Overall Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course the student will be able to:

1. greet and escort patients from the waiting area to the treatment room;
2. recognize physical limitations of patients;
3. recognize need for and use appropriate precautions;
4. take actions to ensure patient privacy;
5. maintain patient confidentiality;
6. participate in maintaining general cleanliness;
7. discard used materials;
8. demonstrate proper use of universal precautions;
9. apply universal precautions and infection control universal precautions;
10. assist with safe patient transfer using proper body mechanics;
11. interact with members of the radiation oncology team and other health care professions to provide multidisciplinary care to oncology patients;
12. demonstrate a working knowledge of medical terminology;
13. demonstrate ethical and professional behavior in the clinical environment;
14. demonstrate how to accurately measure with calipers and rulers using the metric system; and
15. demonstrate the accurate use of measuring with syringes and beakers in cc, millimeters, meters.
