Description

Internship in Communications

Provides practical experience in a work environment for the advanced student (in Journalism, Speech, Mass Communications, Computer Graphics and Visual Communication). Includes work experiences in business, industry, educational institutions, social services organizations, or other agencies involved in the appropriate communications activity. Requires supervision by an appropriate advisor during the internship, establishment of learning objectives, and a journal documenting the completion of the learning objectives.

1-6 credits; 3-20 laboratory hours per week. Prerequisite: Six credits in the major area and permission of program coordinator.
