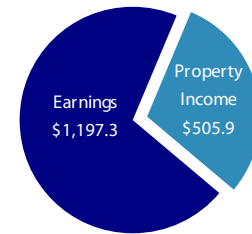


### CCBC Stimulates Economic Growth

- CCBC's past and present activities in the workforce account for \$1.2 billion in earnings and \$505.9 million in property income (i.e., dividends, interest, and rent) of the region's current economy.
- Altogether, the CCBC Service Area economy owes roughly \$1.7 billion of its current income to the annual operations of CCBC and the cumulative effects of its past students.

### CCBC Raises Consumer Spending

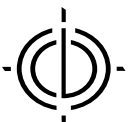
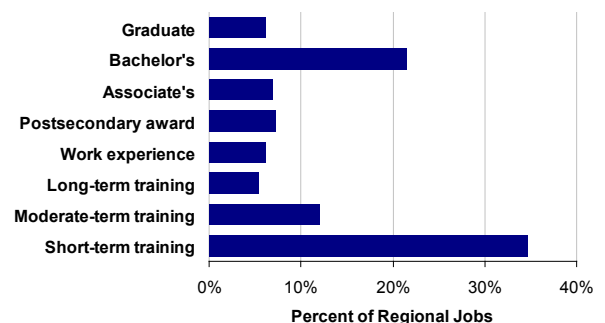


- CCBC employed 1,180 full-time and 1,231 part-time faculty and staff during FY 2005-06, with an annual payroll of \$104.1 million.
- CCBC had a total operating budget of \$144.7 million, of which \$95.6 million (or 66%) was spent in the local region.
- Approximately 12% of CCBC's student body came from outside the region. These students spent an estimated \$538,400 in the region while attending CCBC.

### CCBC Creates a Skilled Workforce

- CCBC activities encourage new business, assist existing business, and create long-term economic growth. The college enhances worker skills and provides customized training to local business and industry.
- It is estimated that the present-day CCBC Service Area workforce embodies about 4.7 million credit hours of past and present CCBC training. These added skills promote business productivity and increase regional income.
