PC Technician	\$35,000
Hardware Support	\$43,700
Helpdesk/Applications Specialist	\$45,000
Trainer	\$55,000
Internet/Web Developer	\$61,800
Game Developer	\$63,500
Network Manager	\$64,000
Systems Administrator	\$64,800
Data Security Analyst	\$67,000
Applications Developer/ Programmer	\$70,000
E-commerce Analyst	\$71,000
