

## EBSCOhost Web - How to Link Articles from a Library Database to a Web Page

### 1. Finding the Articles in the Databases:

Go to the Magazine/Journal database web pages:

## 7.Copy Pages:

- Copy page to another HTML software. (Dreamweaver, FrontPage, Netscape Composer)
- You can use Notepad or Wordpad to save this information.
- Notepad is available on the Start menu, then Programs, then Accessories.  
**Do not use Microsoft Word. It creates splicing URL problems.)**
- To Copy: Edit Select ALL, then Edit Copy.
- Or Highlight what you want copied and do Control C to copy than Control V to paste.
- **In you HTML editor - Delete any hypertext link for the articles at this time.**
- **You must use the persistent link for each article.**

## 8.How to Copy Persistent Link or Durable URL

- To copy persistent link you have to go into each article to see the persistent link.
- Click on an article title and find persistent link before the article abstract.

## 9.Where to Copy & Upload:

- Copy to WebCT page or faculty web page
- Highlight copied article title in Dreamweaver, Front Page, or another HTML composer used for WebCT or a faculty web pages.
- Paste article web address in appropriate link box for whatever type of HTML software you are using.
- Or use Control C to copy than Control V to paste.
