

## COLLEGE-WIDE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GREAT PROJECT

The Academic Deans have been asked to provide a schedule to implement GREAT assessments in all courses listed in the General Education offerings "Round1". The first round of data collection began in Spring 2004 (see round 1 schedule below). Round 2 reassessment will begin in Fall 2007 (see round 2 schedule below).

All courses within a general education discipline area administer their GREAT common graded assignments (CGAs) the same semester. This allows for an easy predictability and thus tracking of which courses are involved which semester. It also allows for new courses to be easily absorbed into the assessment structure.
