“The Hilton Mansion Rehabilitation Campaign”

A MAINSTAY OF THE COMMUNITY FOR MORE THAN 50 YEARS, the Community College of Baltimore County has long been the place where people come for education, career training, recreation, sports and cultural events. Generations of area residents have come to know and love the CCBC Catonsville campus and its blend of tradition and innovation, history and potential.

The completion of the CCBC Catonsville library marks the beginning of an exciting new chapter in the life of the college and the communities it serves. Construction of the \$28 million building began in March 2009, with funds jointly contributed by both Baltimore County and the state of Maryland.

At the opposite end of the campus facilities history is the Hilton Mansion, one of CCBC Catonsville’s most treasured buildings. The Mansion has occupied a prominent space on the community landscape since it was constructed in the early 17th century.

Built between 1828 and 1835 by Dr. Lennox Birckhead, this grand old building is a wonderful example of the stately architecture and elaborate craftsmanship of the time. It was later purchased by the Glenn family, who lived in the home and hosted such distinguished guests as Robert E. Lee.

In continuous use by the college since that time, the Hilton mansion currently houses CCBC Catonsville administrative offices.

The college and its community friends are anxious to restore this timeless architectural jewel to its former elegance. At an approximate cost of \$6 million, the newly restored Hilton mansion will serve as a signature building on campus, aptly reflecting the home's dignity and heritage.

The rehabilitated building will augment the college's instructional capacity with classroom space for seminar-sized education and training venues. Additionally, it will serve as a gracious and graceful hospitality, meeting and reception venue for both internal and external communities.

The Hilton Mansion will be home to two of CCBC's signature programs—"The Center for Global Education," and "The CCBC Honors Program."
