Cooperative Education and Off-Campus Work Experience

Description

AUTO 281 – 1 credit - Cooperative Education and Off-Campus Work Experience provides opportunity for Off-Campus Work Experience in Automotive Technology; required by General Motors (ASEP), Ford Motor Company (ASSET), Toyota Motors (T-TEN) and Global programs; programs are eight weeks in length and 40 hours per week.

1 credit

Prerequisite: AUTO 156, 136, 151, 161, and 241.

Overall Course Objectives

This course will reinforce the objectives from the second year of the ASEP, ASSET, T-TEN and Global programs in the following courses: AUTO 156, 136, 151, 161, and 241.

Course Requirements

The students will maintain their employment with the assigned dealership and perform all duties associated with the program.

Grading/Exams:

Grading procedures will be determined by the individual faculty member and will include the following:

1. Attendance and participation 30%
2. The task mastery from National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF) master course list70%

Written Assignments: The individual faculty member will determine specific writing assignments and students are required to utilize appropriate academic resources.
