Description

DEMT 181 – 1 Credit -- Cooperative Education/Internship (Off-Campus Work Experience)

engages students in an off-campus work experience in diesel and equipment maintenance technology. Students receive academic credit for knowledge and skill outcomes derived from a planned work experience. Students are expected to work for eight weeks with a minimum of 40 hours per week under the mentorship of an experienced technician.

Prerequisites: Completion of 12 credits in program and GPA of 2.0 and signature of Program Coordinator

Overall Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

1. participate in the job search process;
2. abide by all safety regulations as required of the workplace;
3. apply appropriate workplace behaviors in a professional setting;
4. demonstrate knowledge and skill appropriate to job assignment related to the program and specific career goals;
5. show evidence of content knowledge gained through practical experience; and
6. evaluate the experience in terms of their personal, educational, and career needs.

Major Topics

Specific objectives will come from course work completed and finalized with program coordinator and may include any of the following topics:

- I. Electrical and electronic systems
- II. Preventive maintenance
- III. Hydraulic systems
- IV. Heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems
- V. Diesel Engines
- VI. Brake systems
- VII. Drive train systems
- VIII. Suspension and steering systems

Course Requirements

The students will maintain their employment and perform all duties associated with the program.

Grading/Exams:

Grading procedures will be determined by the individual faculty member and will include the following:

- 1. Attendance and Participation..... 30%
- 2. The task mastery from NATEF Tasks from master course list 70%

Writing:

The individual faculty member will determine specific writing assignments, but all students will maintain a log of their daily activities on the job.
