I. General Course Description

Hospitality Management Internship

Provides an opportunity for the student to obtain an applied management internship in a specialized area of the hospitality industry; emphasis is placed on meeting the needs of both the student and the hospitality operation offering the management internship.

Prerequisite: 30 HRMT completed hours

When the student completes the course, he/she will be able to:

- A. Explain the management structure of his/her internship site.
- B. Develop a working knowledge of one or two operating departments in the internship site.
- C. Describe supervisory duties.
- D. Write a management internship report.
- E. Explain the mission statement of the sponsorship internship site.
- F. Describe the corporate culture of the sponsoring internship site.
