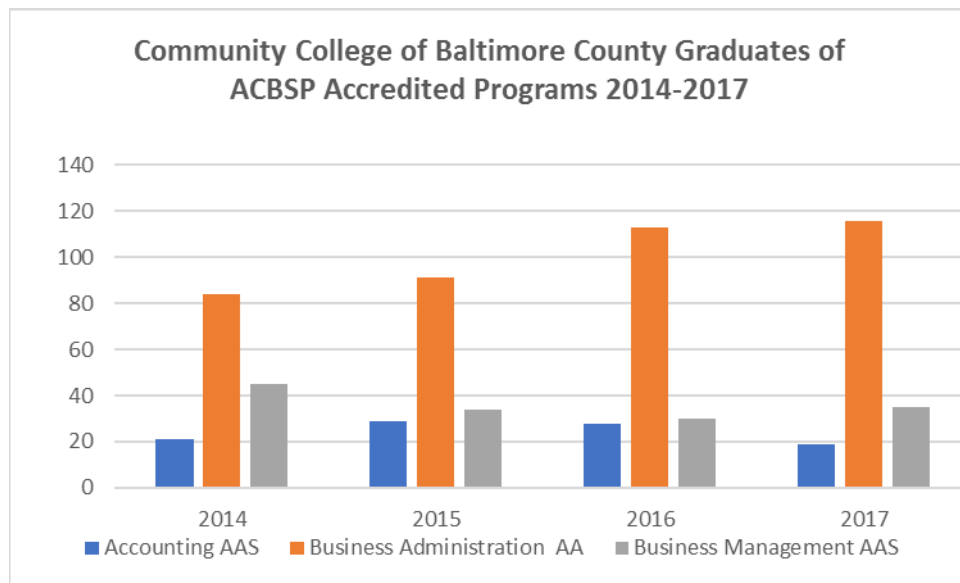




CHEA Student Achievement
