

CCBC Aviation Program Transfer Guidelines

These guidelines have been established to aid students with prior college coursework in determining what credits will transfer into the Aviation Program Curricula. Students wishing to obtain credit for their FAA Pilot Certificates and Ratings will also find this useful.

General Education Courses

General education courses completed with a grade of C or above will usually transfer as long as the course descriptions and number of credits match.

Aviation Courses

Aviation courses completed within a 4-year period with a grade of B or above will usually transfer as long as the course descriptions and number of credits match.

Credit granted for Private, Instrument & Commercial Pilot Ground School Courses completed at other colleges and universities are subject to approval from the Aviation Department.

FAA Pilot Certificates

Students holding an **FAA Private Pilot Certificate** will be granted credit for AVMT 141 and either AVMT 142 or AVMT 143.

Students holding an **FAA Instrument Pilot Rating** will be granted credit for AVMT 241 and either AVMT 242 or AVMT 243.

Students holding an **FAA Commercial Pilot Certificate** will be granted credit for AVMT 246 and AVMT 247.
