Eligibility Guidelines for Tuition Waiver for Continuing Education Students with Disabilities

General Information for Non-Credit Students

House Bill 53 enacted by the 2012 Maryland General Assembly reinstates the disability tuition waiver for Continuing Education courses that lead to employment, including life skills instruction.

Continuing Education Courses Eligible For This Tuition Waiver

The tuition waiver is for courses that lead to employment, including life skills instruction.

Student Eligibility

1. Eligible students include any resident of Maryland who is out of the workforce because of a permanent disability, as defined by the Social Security Act, the Railroad Retirement Act, or in the case of former federal employees, from the individual's federal retirement or pension authority. Please note that individuals receiving SSI or SSDI benefits as a dependent or survivor of a disabled beneficiary do not qualify for this waiver.
2. The Certification of SSI/SSDI Disability form is valid for one academic year. You can take the completed certification form to any Enrollment Services Office or you can mail the form to:

For students applying for Surgical Technology or Medical Assistant Programs, you must complete the FAFSA in order to determine your eligibility for federal financial aid before the tuition waiver can be applied. If you are found eligible for federal financial assistance, the federal aid will be applied before receiving the tuition waiver
