CCBC recognizes that a student's SSN is confidential and will protect the number from unauthorized disclosure and/or use. The SSN is used for complying with various state and federal reporting requirements. If you fail to provide your correct SSN or TIN, you may be charged a \$50.00 penalty by the IRS. Federal law requires CCBC to report to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) the name, address, and SSN of persons from whom tuition and related expenses are received. The IRS relies on such information to certify education related tax credits. You will not receive the 1098-T form for federal tuition tax credits because the federal government requires an SSN. Refusal to provide SSN may mean that you will not be awarded any federal financial aid, which includes loans, grants, or scholarships.
