

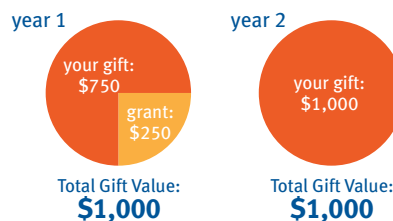
UNITED WAY OF CENTRAL MARYLAND GIVING SOCIETIES

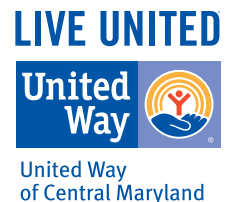
