First-Year Experience Summer Bridge Program Interest Form

CCBC Student Life's First-Year Experience (FYE) Summer Bridge Program aims to support first-year students in their quest for college completion.

The program includes two core components:

- (1) A Summer Academic Development 101 Course
- (2) Co-curricular Engagement (Out-of-Classroom Experiences)

Through participation in the Summer Bridge Program, students will be better prepared for their college experience at CCBC. In particular, students can expect the following outcomes from their participation:

- Students will complete their first college course (summer ACDV 101).
- Students will feel more confident in their ability to successfully re-enroll in courses at CCBC.
- Students will be able to identify campus offices and/or representatives who can assist them in their college endeavors.

Required Criteria

- Have a completed CCBC admissions application on file
- Agree to participate in one of the following summer ACDV courses from July 8 to July 19, 2019
 - Monday through Friday, 9:00 AM to 11:15 AM on the CCBC Catonsville campus
 - Monday through Friday, 9:00 AM to 11:15 AM on the CCBC Essex campus
- Agree to participate in out-of-classroom experiences over the summer
 - All Day Team Building at Genesee Valley Outdoor Learning Center with Free Lunch & Transportation Included: Monday, July 8
 - Strengths Workshop with Free Lunch Included: Extended Class on Monday, 7/15
 - Group Service Project with Free Lunch Included: Extended Class on Wednesday, 7/17
 - Class Celebration: Extended Final Class Meeting until 1:00 PM with Free Lunch Included
 - New Student Orientation (NSO): Select an August Date from the NSO Schedule
 - Monthly One-on-One Peer Mentoring Sessions with an FYE Summer Bridge Retention Mentor in September, October, November, and December 2019
