On a rain-soaked Saturday in September, the Maryland Consortium for Adjunct Faculty Professional Development (MCAPD) held its second annual Adjunct Faculty Conference at CCBC Catonsville .

On September 27, over 200 adjunct faculty from around the state of Maryland gathered from over 15 colleges to exchange ideas and attend professional development workshops.

Attendees had over 25 workshops to choose from with the overriding theme being "Adjunct Meets the Students: Opportunities for Excellence."

Dr. Kurtinitis, president of CCBC gave the opening remarks and then welcomed, Charlene Nunley, President Emeritus, Montgomery College who addressed the theme.

"I have never attended one of the Adjunct Faculty Conferences without coming away with some very illuminating and helpful ideas to apply to my teaching," said Gerry Hughes, instructor for the Senior Institute at CCBC.
