

CCBC STUDENT ENGAGEMENT First-Year Experience Summer Bridge Program Interest Form

CCBC Student Engagement's First-Year Experience (FYE) Summer Bridge Program aims to support first-year students in their quest for college completion.

The 2024 virtual summer program includes two core components:

- (1) A Remote Online Academic Development (ACDV) 101 Course (Required Course for Graduation)
- (2) Co-curricular Engagement (Remote Out-of-Classroom Experiences)

Through participation in the Summer Bridge Program, students will be better prepared for their college experience at CCBC. In particular, students can expect the following outcomes from their participation:

- Students will complete their first college course (summer ACDV 101).
- Students will feel more confident in their ability to successfully re-enroll in courses at CCBC.
- Students will be able to identify campus offices and/or representatives who can assist them in their college endeavors.

Required Criteria

- Have a completed CCBC admissions application on file for Summer 2024
- Agree to participate in a two-week remote section of ACDV 101 from July 15 to July 26, 2024
 - o Classes will meet remotely Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM to 11:15 AM
- Agree to participate in remote online out-of-classroom experiences over the summer
 - o Virtual Team Building: In Class, Monday, July 15, 9:00 AM to 11:15 AM
 - o Service Reflection & Presentation: Extended Class Time until 1:30 PM on July 22
 - Myers-Briggs Type Indicator Workshop: Extended Class Time until 1:30 PM on July 24
 - o Class Celebration: Extended Final Class Meeting until 1:30 PM on July 26
- Agree to participate in New Student Orientation (NSO): Select an August Date from the Schedule
- Agree to participate in mentoring sessions throughout the fall and spring semesters
 - o Monthly One-on-One Mentoring Sessions with FYE staff (Retention Specialist)

Program Cost

CCBC Student Engagement's First-Year Experience Program aims to financially support students in the Summer Bridge Program by sponsoring their tuition, fees, and book for the ACDV 101 course and by covering the cost of the associated co-curricular experiences. Therefore, Summer Bridge students are expected to participate in all remote class meetings and all online and remote out-of-classroom experiences. They are also expected to complete their ACDV 101 course with a passing grade. If students do not meet these expectations, they will be responsible for their ACDV 101 course tuition and fees.

When expected to be present in class meetings and workshops, students are not permitted to multi-task (such as work a job or complete course assignments – unless your instructor has scheduled class time for the completion of assignments).
