HOW TO REGISTER:

- No phone or mail-in registration. **Registrations are in-person ONLY.**
- All students MUST go to one of the “**WALK-IN PLACEMENT AND REGISTRATION LOCATIONS AND TIMES**” on the dates and time listed.
- **Students are registered on a first-come, first-served basis and classes fill up quickly! Arrive on time!**
- **Only registering students are allowed during the registration process.** Family members or friends must wait in another area.
- Do not come late!
- Test Procedures are subject to change.
- You are enrolled once you receive a copy of your **Registration Welcome Packet** at registration.

New Students: Must take a test.

Returning Students: Returning students may not have to take a test if they show on their phone a picture of paperwork, the Referral Form or a Certificate from the previous class semester to help with placement.

NOTE:

- Students must be at least 18 years of age and not enrolled or planning to attend high school to register in one of the ESOL classes.
- Students with an **F-1 or J-1 Visa are not eligible** for LABOR grant-funded* classes.
