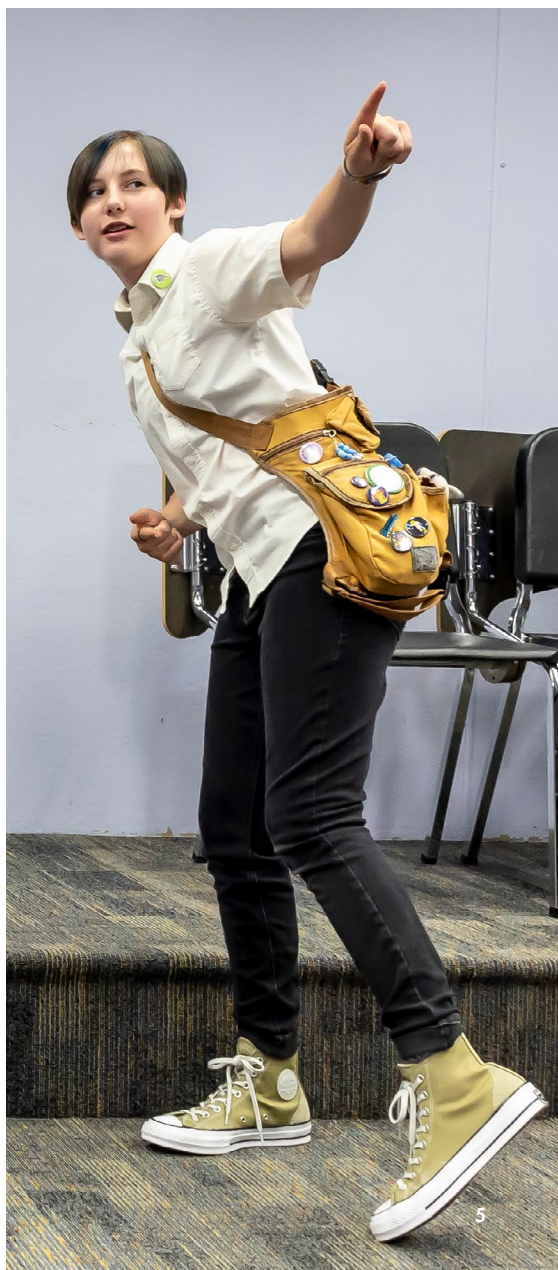

## EARLY PAYMENT PLAN

To have monthly payments automatically deducted from a checking, savings or credit card account, the parent/guardian of the student must complete a Nelnet Business Solutions application once the registration has been processed. An initial down payment (20% of the total) toward the costs of the student's course(s) and a \$25 non-refundable processing fee to Nelnet Business Solutions is required at the time of registration. A two-month plan option must total between \$200 and \$499. A three-month plan option must total \$500 or greater. The total amount is to be paid in full prior to the first day of class.
