FIRE

Please see the below emergency procedures to be followed in the event of a fire, explosion, or smoke event on campus or at a CCBC extension center. Remember "What to do in an Emergency" fliers and evacuation routes are posted in classrooms for handy reference.

1. If you discover a fire, explosion or smoke in a building,

- a. Activate the fire alarm system: Find a wall-mounted red pull station and pull down its lever.
- b. Call Public Safety at 443 840-1111. Provide your location and specify the type of incident (fire, explosion, smoke, burning odor, etc.)

2. When a fire alarm sounds,

- a. Evacuate the building immediately
- b. Remain approximately 100 feet from exterior building exits
- c. Carry your cellphone and class roster with you.
- d. Notify authorities if anyone from your class or office area is missing.

3. If there is a disabled person in your vicinity on the second floor or above

- a. Assist the individual to the nearest stairwell as the "area of refuge".
- b. Immediately contact 911 with the person's location.
- c. Stay with the person, if you can, until rescue personnel arrive.
- 4. **<u>Do not</u>** use the elevators during a fire, explosion or smoke emergency.
- 5. **Do not** re-enter the building until told to do so by on site authorities, or until you hear the alert tone and "All Clear" signal from the Whelan Alert System.
