TORNADO / SEVERE WEATHER

Please see the below emergency procedures to be followed in the event of a Tornado or Severe Weather Emergency on campus or at a CCBC extension center. Remember "What to do in an Emergency" fliers and evacuation routes are posted in classrooms for handy reference

Tornado or Severe Thunderstorm Watch:

A tornado or severe thunderstorm watch means severe weather is possibly approaching. Continue normal activities but also continue to monitor the situation.

Tornado or Severe Thunderstorm Warning:

- 1. If possible, proceed to a ground level or underground level of the building.
- 2. **Do not** use elevators
- 3. Stay in a "safe shelter location" like a central hallway, stay away from windows, mirrors, glass, and unsecured objects such as filing cabinets or book cases.
- 4. Remain alert for falling objects.
- 5. Carry your cellphone and class roster with you.
- 6. Remain in the "safe shelter location" until the tornado/severe thunderstorm warning has expired.
- 7. Report injuries to Public Safety at 443 840-1111 or 911.

If there is a disabled person in your vicinity on the second floor or above

- a. Assist the individual to the nearest stairwell as the "area of refuge".
- b. Immediately contact Public Safety at 443 840-1111 with the person's location.
- c. Stay with the person, if you can, until rescue personnel arrive.
