2020 – 2021: Bankruptcy/Default Status

The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) indicates that you have one or more student loans in an active **bankruptcy** and **default** status.

According to Federal Student Aid Publication (FSA) GEN-95-40, a borrower who lists a defaulted FSA loan in an active bankruptcy claim is not eligible for further federal student aid funds. The only exception is if the student provides the school with documentation from the holder of the debt stating that it is dischargeable (NSLDS loan status code DO).

You may access your student loan information including the holder of your defaulted loan/s on-line at www.nsls.ed.gov (Financial Aid Review) using your FSA Username and Password. If you desire to receive financial aid for the 2020-2021 academic year, you must contact the holder of the defaulted loan/s and request documentation from them stating that your loan/s are dischargeable.
