1. CCBC Application for Admission
2. Certified copy of high school transcripts in English that verifies completion of secondary school
3. Proof of English Language Proficiency with one of the following:
 - Official TOEFL score report with a minimum score of 450 on the paper-based test or 133 on the computerized test or 45 on the iBT test. (Please use CCBC TOEFL code # 5137)
 - IELTS score report with a 5.0 or higher.

Note: Students from English speaking countries are not required to take TOEFL or IELTS.

4. Declaration of Financial Support form
5. Original financial statements to verify sufficient funds. These statements must
 - a. Be written in English on bank letterhead
 - b. Display the sponsor's name as the owner of the account
 - c. Be less than 6 months old
 - d. Show a minimum of \$26,411 in U.S. dollars

6. A copy of your Passport

7. Personal Data sheet

After you have submitted all of the above documents to the International Student Services office, an International Student Services counselor will review them. Upon approval, a CCBC acceptance letter, an I-20 and information about the I-901 SEVIS fee will be mailed. You will need these documents to apply for your F-1 Visa.

Please list on a separate sheet of paper the individual's full name, birth date, country of birth, country of citizenship, and relationship to the student. The financial sponsor must include the necessary funding required by the family member(s).

What International Students Need to Know about Transfer Credit, Health Insurance and Finances

Transfer Credits

Credits earned at an accredited college or university outside the USA can often be transferred and applied towards your degree at CCBC. To transfer credits to CCBC, you must submit transcripts, diplomas, certificates and supporting documents to the American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (www.aacrao.org) or World Education Services (www.wes.org) for evaluation. CCBC will determine how many courses are applicable to your degree. Transcript evaluation will waive ACDV 101, the one credit college orientation course.

Find Health Insurance

F-1 students are required to purchase health insurance and to show proof of coverage each semester of enrollment at CCBC. Any health insurance plan must include medical evacuation and repatriation of remains. The cost of health insurance varies widely. In some cases, the best health insurance options may be available in your home country for purchase before you leave.

Prepare Finances

Since all school expense payments are due at the beginning of each semester and wiring money can take time, we recommend bringing enough money to cover the first year's expenses in the form of traveler's checks, credit cards or a combination of cash and a certified U.S. bank check. Report your funds to U. S. Customs when entering the U.S.

Review American Essay Writing

Most new international students are required to take an English placement test and the TOEFL or IELTS. To achieve the best results, we recommend that you review American style essay writing.
