**Independent Study in ART**

**1-3 Semester Hour(s)**

## **The Community College of Baltimore County**

### **Description**

A faculty-mentored, independent course of study in which the students, with the consent of the instructor, may elect to do independent research and projects in the ARTS.

### **Overall Course Objectives**

Upon successful completion of this course students will be able to:

1. Achieve objectives beyond the current course offerings into areas of more advanced study and technique;
2. Experience alternative modes of instruction
3. Maximize the level of instruction in Art by pursuing a program of individualized instruction and independent work.

The design of the proposed study includes specific project objectives to be achieved by the student and a schedule of meetings and criticism, and is individually contracted between the student and the department.

### **Major Topics**

To be determined by the written independent study contract and approved by the department chair and the division dean

### **Course Requirements**

Methods of evaluation to be enumerated in the contract but must include written documentation and research as well as a creative performance or portfolio.

### **Other Course Information**

Written contract from the department and the division must be presented at registration. Six credits may be applied toward graduation.
