Description

Cooperative Education and Off-Campus Work Experience

Provides an opportunity for Off-Campus Work Experience in Automotive Technology; this internship is required by General Motors (ASEP), Ford Motor Company (ASSET), and Toyota Motors (T-TEN) programs; programs are eight weeks in length and are a minimum of 40 hours per week.

Overall Course Objectives

This course will reinforce the objectives from the first year of the ASEP, ASSET, and T-TEN programs in the following courses: AUTO 101, 121, 131, and 141.

Course Requirements

The students will maintain their employment with the assigned dealership and perform all duties associated with the program.

Grading/Exams:

Grading procedures will be determined by the individual faculty member and will include the following:

1. Attendance and Participation 30%
2. The task mastery from NATAF Tasks from master course list 70%

Writing:

The individual faculty member will determine specific writing assignments.
