Course Title: Construction Craft IV

Description

Construction Craft IV is awarded after the completion of a three, four, or five year Craft Apprenticeship program.

CONT 104 – 6 Credits – Construction Craft IV provides for the awarding of articulated credits after completing a craft apprenticeship program, which complies with approved standards set by the Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Council or other apprenticeship governing boards. The class is to recognize the work completed in the fourth year of the apprenticeship program. credits: 6

Prerequisite: The student must have completed a Craft Apprenticeship recognized by approved standards set by the Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Council or other apprenticeship governing boards.

Overall Course Objectives

The student will have completed the requirements of the fourth year of a craft apprenticeship program.

Major Topics

Topics are related to each of the individual craft apprenticeship programs.

Course Requirements

Grading/exams: Grading procedures will be determined by the individual craft apprenticeship program which complies with approved standards set by the Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Council or other apprenticeship governing boards.
