Description

Directed Practicum: Environmental Science

Provides valuable applied worksite experience through a coordinated work experience with a private, non-profit or government environmental employer.

Prerequisite: Permission of program coordinator.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of course, student will be able to

1. Better assess likely future job opportunities.
2. Integrate knowledge sets learned in the classroom with skill sets needed in the workplace.
3. Conduct themselves in a professional manner in the workplace.

Additional objectives are a function of the type of practicum students pursue.

Major Topics

1. Approval by Program Coordinator is required for student Practicum placement.
2. A formal contract between the employer, student and CCC will be drafted.
3. A faculty member will be in charge of monitoring student's progress.
4. A final evaluation by all parties is required.

Additional topics are a function of the type of practicum students pursue.

Course Requirements

Grading procedures will be determined by the individual faculty member as appropriate based on prior practice and experience.

ENVS 271-276 serves as an additional course option in the A.A.S. degree and certificate programs in Environmental Science and Technology.
