Course Outline GEOA 291-293 Independent Study, Geospatial Applications 1-3 Semester Hours

Description

Cooperative Education, Geospatial Applications provides the opportunity for study or research in an area of particular interest to the student under the guidance of a faculty member. The course requires submission of a written report at the end of the semester.

Prerequisites: GEOA 110 and consent of program coordinator
Written approval from program coordinator must be submitted for registration

Course Requirements

The specific course requirements will be determined in consultation with the student and the faculty member.

Other Course Information

This course is a GEOA elective course.
Course credits can be 1 (GEOA 291), 2 (GEOA 292) or 3 (GEOA 293) depending on scope and number of hours to be worked.

Can be taken twice for credit for a maximum of six credits
