### Description

Pediatrics II

Provides Physician Assistant students with exposure to the mechanism and natural course of the disease process in the pediatric patient; the second part of a two-part course.

### Overall Course Objectives

At the conclusion of the course the student will be able to:

- A. Describe presenting signs and symptoms of diseases discussed;
- B. Formulate a differential diagnosis;
- C. Synthesize a management plan for the diagnoses;
- D. Describe special considerations in pediatric management, e.g. dosing and imaging;
- E. Explore special topics in peds, e.g., fetal alcohol/substance abuse syndromes, AIDS and child abuse.

- A. Pediatric Orthopedics
- B. Serious Bacterial Infections, Viral Infections (Meningitis, TB, AIDS)
- C. Pediatric Urology
- D. Pediatric Ophthalmology
- E. Pediatric Neoplasms (Wilms)
- F. The Abused Child
