

Criminal Justice Studies Internship Sites

The list below represents agencies willing to accept our intern students. Some of the agencies require an application process and background investigation. The law enforcement agencies listed will not accept students with pending or past criminal and/or civil litigation. This list is not inclusive and other criminal justice related entities may be considered. Some examples include courts, prosecutor's offices, public defender's offices, law firms, security agencies, federal criminal justice agencies, and criminal justice agencies outside of Baltimore County.

Students should attempt to make contact in person. If that is not possible, a phone call, followed by an e-mail (if available) should be made. It may take several attempts before you receive a response (reason why making contact in person is the preferred method).

When making personal contact, dress appropriately and be polite in all communications. Once you are accepted, work with your site supervisor in developing a schedule that is conducive to both you and the agency. Be a dependable worker and show up for work when expected and on time. Keep in mind that you are their guest and they have opened their doors to give you a learning experience. Moreover, you will be representing the College, the Criminal Justice Studies Program, and students who will follow in your path.
