

**Honors Program Memorandum of Understanding Between**  
Goucher College and the Community College of Baltimore County

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this agreement between Goucher College and the Community College of Baltimore County (CCBC) is to recognize outstanding academic achievement of CCBC honors students, and to provide for a smooth and successful transition from CCBC Honors Program to Goucher College.

**CRITERIA**

Transfer students from the CCBC Honors Program are guaranteed admission into Goucher College during the Fall or Spring semester provided the student has met the following criteria:

- Has applied to Goucher College.
- Has met all requirements of CCBC Honors Program prior to transferring to Goucher College.
- Confirmation required from the Director of the CCBC Honors Program.
- Has completed the Associate Degree and/or a minimum of 60 undergraduate units from CCBC.
- Has at least a 3.5 cumulative GPA at the time of application to Goucher College.

**OTHER PROVISIONS**

- CCBC and Goucher College will collaborate to develop a scholarship agreement for CCBC honors students to supplement this academic articulation agreement.
- Both institutions agree to meet regularly to share information on program updates, curricular and program changes and all processes relative to this agreement.
- This agreement becomes effective upon the signing of both parties and shall continue in effect until both parties agree in writing to modify or terminate the agreement. Termination of the agreement shall become effective ninety (90) days after written notice is given.
