1. Submit completed application to the Bursar Office with payment (check payable to CCBC). If mailing application submit with payment to: Registrar's Office CCBC Essex Student Services Center, Room 015 7201 Rossville Boulevard Baltimore MD, 21237-3899.
2. Transfer Credit: If you have transfer credits, submit an official copy if needed to complete requirements.
3. Commencement: CCBC hosts one annual commencement ceremony at the end of the spring semester for students earning degrees in August, December, or May. Email communication regarding commencement is sent in early spring. Visit www.ccbcmd.edu/graduation for additional information.
